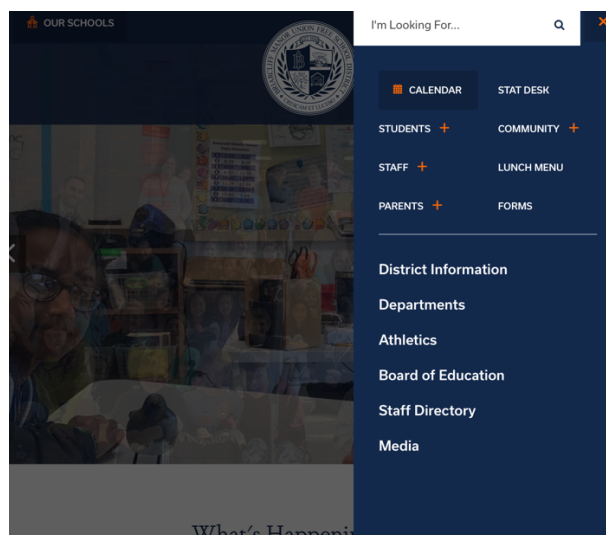


## How to Sheet- Accessing Atlas for Curriculum Mapping

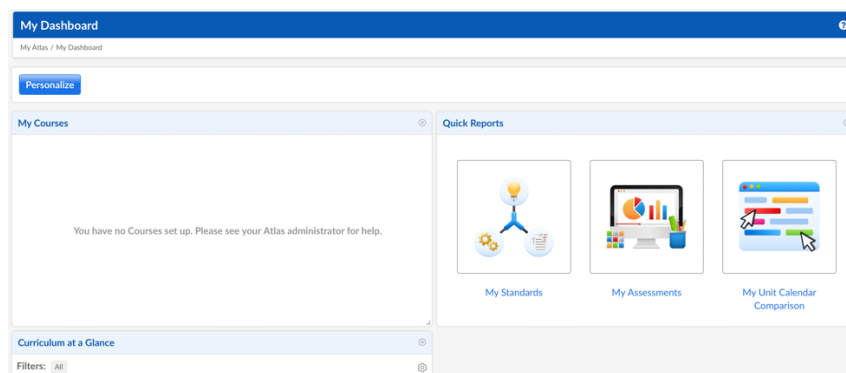

3) Under applications find Atlas.

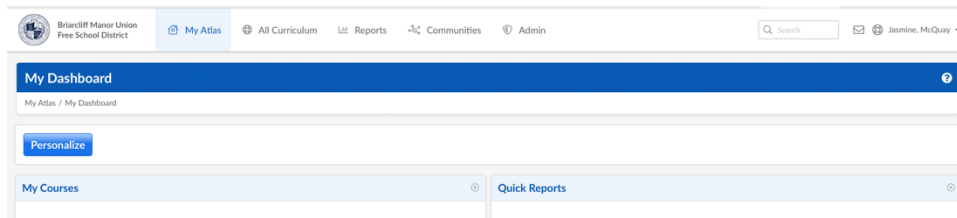


4) Login to Atlas

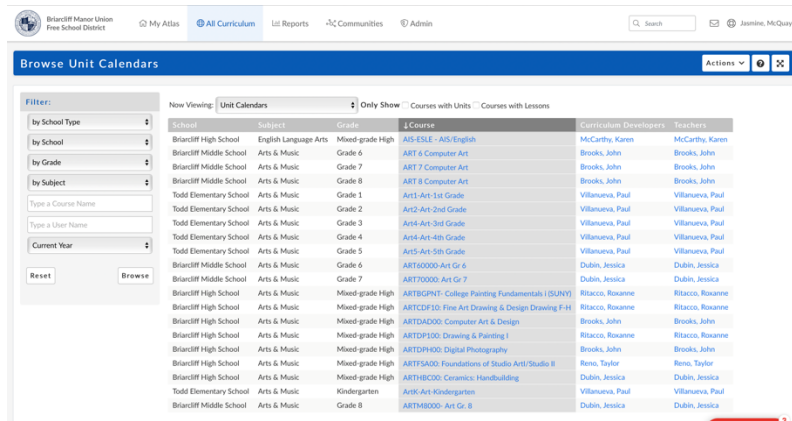
5) Your Dashboard will show you your courses.



6) If your dashboard does not show you any curriculum you may click on the bar at the top of website. Click on Curriculum:

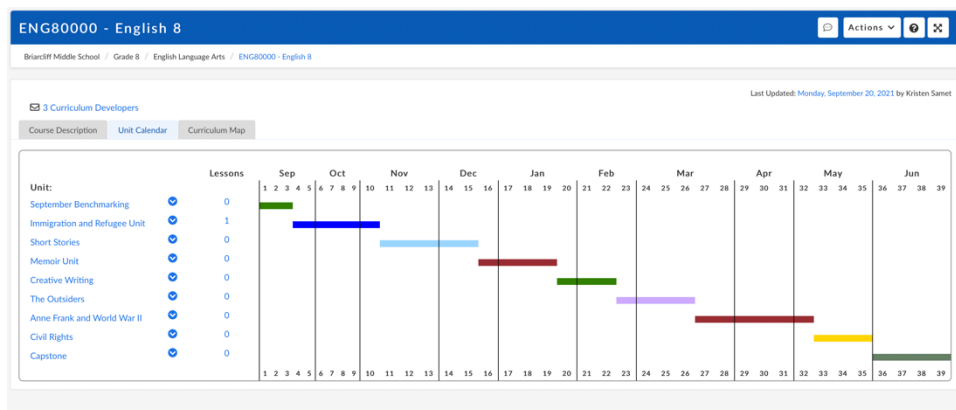


7) Once you click on Curriculum you should be able to explore the unit and curriculum available to you and you can filter as you want. See example below:
