- S. Mattey updated the committee on the budget process. At this point, the proposed 2015/16 budget includes:
 - o Duct cleaning for 24 classrooms, the MS cafeteria and the HS gym.
 - Replacing two chimneys at Todd
 - o Painting at HS & Todd
 - o 24 interior doors upstairs at HS
 - o Gym floor lining
 - o Replacement of fire control panel at Todd
 - o Ceiling fans in K-2 cafeteria
- Areas of concern due to weather damage
 - It was noted that sidewalks throughout the District are heaving and blacktop is coming apart. Some of the heaving will correct itself once the weather gets warmer. Other areas will be repaired in the spring. The Facilities Committee is focusing on major repairs needed throughout the parking lot and driveways.
 - Roof leaks will be addressed once all the snow in gone. The bid for the roofing company will be awarded on Monday.
- Concerns:
 - M. Diamente Woman's faculty bathroom persistently leaking toilet A. Bauso will look into.
 - A. Medeo getting reports of K-2 playground injuries especially among the 2nd graders but they are not finding their way into her office. There may be a reduced amount of space because of the snow piles.
