Anthony Muranelli Jr. Scholarship

The Briarcliff Teachers' Association has established a scholarship for current seniors at Briarcliff High School who plan to enroll in a full-time course of study at an accredited college or university. This is a one time award.

The scholarship is in memory of former Spanish teacher Anthony Muranelli Jr. who died on December 18, 2018. Mr. Muranelli taught Spanish in both the middle school and high school for 24 years before retiring in June of 2013. During and after his career at Briarcliff, he kept in contact with many of his former students. He was not just their teacher but a friend and a mentor.

Consistent with Mr. Muranelli's love for teaching and languages, the scholarship will be awarded to a student who meets one of the following criteria:

- wants to be a primary or secondary teacher
- demonstrates outstanding commitment to promoting, developing and enhancing primary and secondary education
- plans on continuing the study of world languages to further enhance his/her global and cultural awareness

These attributes characterize the passion that Mr. Muranelli had for his career therefore the recipient must meet one of them.

Students must complete the application and submit it with their high school transcript to Mrs. Gordon at the high school no later than April 15 at 3:00PM. Applicants are solely responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. All information submitted is confidential and will be reviewed only by the High School World Language Department.

Scholarship recipient or recipients will be selected on the basis of academic achievement, leadership and participation in school, community and/or work experiences related to the intention of the scholarship, and recommendation by an adult. The scholarship will be awarded in May at the awards ceremony. A one-time check will be given to the student.
