The Briarcliff Manor Police Benevolent Association scholarship award application will be available for qualified, eligible candidates. The Scholarship Committee, through funding of the Briarcliff Manor Police Benevolent Association will offer a combination of two (2) Scholarship Awards up to \$500.00 each. One Scholarship Award will be offered to a Briarcliff Manor High School student while the other will be offered to an Ossining High School student. These awards are made possible by the proceeds from fund drives held by the Association together with contributions from our membership and the community.

Eligibility for the scholarship award will be based upon the following Qualification:

- 1) The applicant must be a resident of the incorporated Village of Briarcliff Manor.
- 2) The application must be a graduating high school senior who will be an enrolled college freshman for the 2019-2020 academic year.
- 3) All applications must be fully completed and received by the Scholarship Committee no later than July 16, 2019. All applications become the property of the Briarcliff Manor Police Benevolent Association.

The award(s) will be distributed to the recipient(s) as follows:

- 1) For the fall semester: 100% of the total awarded amount.
- 2) A letter of acceptance must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee with proof of enrollment (a copy of the tuition invoice).
- 3) The award will be paid directly to the recipient's college.
- 4) All decisions of this Association's Scholarship Committee are final.
- 5) Notification to recipient(s) will be made prior to the fall semester.
- 6) Students receiving full scholarships from other sources are not eligible.

Application forms must be received no later than July 16, 2019.
