STORMWATER MANAGEMENT MISSION STATEMENT

On December 8, 1999, under the provisions of the Federal Clean Water Act, USEPA required operators of "small" public entities to develop programs to control stormwater discharges under their jurisdictions.

Accordingly, in June 2006, the BMSD filed a Notice of Intent to comply with the Phase II Stormwater Regulations. The Stormwater Management Program (SWMP), administered by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), requires the BMSD to implement the following six (6) measurable goals to minimize pollutant runoff from stormwater discharges:

- Public Education and Outreach Program
- Public Involvement and Participation
- Elimination of Illicit Discharges
- Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Controls
- Post-construction Stormwater Runoff Management Controls
- Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping
